## **VIRTUAL "600" TOURNAMENT RULES**

1. Eligibility for this tournament is limited to bowlers who are current members of USBC, SD State USBC and a local South Dakota Bowling Association who have bowled at least one USBC Certified "600" 3-game series at some time during their bowling career.
2. All prize money will be returned 100% in cash and awards. An award will be presented to the champion. In case of a tie for the championship, co-champions will be declared and duplicate awards will be given.

**Insufficient Funds Checks: Subject to \$30.00 charge and entry rejection.**

3. **ENTERING AVERAGES:** Entrants in the SD STATE USBC Virtual "600" TOURNAMENT must be members in good standing with the SD STATE USBC, a local South Dakota USBC association and USBC. The average used in the SDSUBC Women's Tournament will be used for this Virtual "600" Tournament.

**USBC Rule 319A 1-3-4 and 319C & E concerning submission of averages is in effect.**

**The 10 pin re-rate rule is not in effect.**

4. Any errors in scoring must be reported and corrected immediately. All scores as recorded on the scoring computer after the completion of each game will be declared final and official.
5. Any protest must be submitted in writing to the tournament manager within 72 hours of close of tournament. No unsigned protest will be considered.
