The scholarship will be formally presented at the annual SD State USBC Jamboree. SMART scholarship funds will be held at USBC under SD State USBC Youth SMART #09268.

Eligibility and Requirements:

1. Youth must be a current SD USBC Youth member in good standing.
2. Youth must be 8th grade or younger.
3. Youth must include an autobiography:
 - Include detailed information describing what you have accomplished to organize and promote youth bowling; i.e., league activities, helping with awards, handing out scoresheets.
 - Personal bowling accomplishments; i.e., new high game, improved average.
4. Nomination must include a letter of reference (from a coach or teacher)
